# 12 Days of Christmas Gift Card Program

The third annual campaign resulted in sales of gift cards to local businesses totalling \$15,000. Participating business owners donated a portion of sales, approximately \$1200, to the Vita Healing Garden at the Vita Health Centre - a much-loved local resource.



#### **Library of Things**

The Library of Things project hosted an open house showcasing the impressive array of equipment acquired this year. Next steps are to determine the lending structure so that local entrepreneurs will be able to use these resources to build their businesses.



# **Career Symposium**

Pivoting our successful in-person career symposium to an online virtual symposium, we created a keynote speaker video and video series that outlined three possible career paths for youth in the region: direct to workforce, entrepreneurial, and post-secondary.



#### **RM of Piney Christmas Hampers**

The last two years we managed the Christmas hamper program, distributing 49 hampers in the RM of Piney in 2022. Thanks to our community for their support. The program is being transitioned to the Sprague Community Fellowship in 2023.



#### **South East Community Services Cooperative**

As one of the three founding partners, along with East Borderland Community Housing and the RM of Piney, the Chamber continued to move forward the vision of assisted living for seniors right here in our region. With funding from EBCH, the Cooperators Foundation and the Manitoba Cooperatives Association, we were able to make significant progress, launching a website, brochure, membership application and continuing to share the membership opportunity. The seed funding grant was submitted to Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation late in 2022.



#### **Expansion to RM of Stuartburn**

The past year has seen interest from our neighbours to the west with businesses, individuals and the RM itself becoming members in the PRCC. We look forward to continued growth as we share the value of a regional chamber throughout SE Manitoba.



#### **Canada Summer Jobs Grant**

The Chamber again received a Canada Summer Jobs grant to hire a youth. Ashlyn Willan received valuable work experience and helped move a number of projects forward including member renewals, the Library of Things open house and the gift card program.



## **Municipal Candidate Meet & Greet**

As the local voice of business, the Chamber hosted a well-attended Candidate Meet & Greet event for the RM of Piney municipal candidates. This event gave candidates standing for election and those who were acclaimed an opportunity to state their position on how they envisioned working with the Chamber to continue improving our region.
